## DID YOU KNOW?





**DID YOU KNOW?.....** A resident in long term care can be counted as a new referral if they are discharged from a therapeutic service and re-referred?

For example: A individual is admitted to long term care and assessed by occupational therapy for services. Services are provided for 6 weeks and then the resident is discharged from OT services. The same resident is re-referred two years later for more OT services. A new referral is counted.

<u>This also applies to inpatients</u>. For example: An inpatient is referred to Clinical Nutrition services. The inpatient receives services from the Registered Dietitian and is discharged from the service. The inpatient is then re-referred for a texture change. A new referral can be counted.
